1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

1.1 APOLOGIES SUBMITTED FOR APPROVAL

There were no apologies for absence submitted.

1.2 APOLOGIES NOT SUBMITTED

No apology had been received from Councillor Karen Webb.

2. TO RECEIVE DISCLOSURES OF PERSONAL INTEREST

No disclosures of interest were declared.

3. DETIORATION OF THE AVENUE ALLOTMENTS.

The Chair advised that the meeting had been called in view of the deterioration of some of the allotment plots, with plots being solely used for chickens, paths not being cut back, some plots not being worked etc. and advised that a lot more can be done if we all work together.

It was brought to the attention of council that the lane at the rear of The Avenue constantly floods and the Chairman advised that he would take this matter up with RCTCBC.

It was reported that some 19 or so plots are also badly affected with rain water coming from the farm area and again the Chairman advised that he would meet with an Officer from RCTCBC in view of this problem.

The Chairman advised that the criteria for the allotments must be met and that each Allotment Plot Holder should have received a copy of the Allotment Agreement issued by the council.

A request was made for a copy of their constitution (which they have recently completed) to be sent to the council to be placed on file and the Chairman advised that they could apply to the Lottery Fund now that they are constituted.

It was suggested that perhaps each allotment plot could be numbered so that they could be easily identified.
