- 6. Financial Grants:** to agree whether to proceed with the Small Grants Scheme opening in July 2022 with applications closing on 31st August 2022.

- 7. Windfarm Grant:** to agree to the request of former Councillor Alex Davies-Jones to donate the remaining £5,000 from last year's Windfarm Payment to Tonyrefail BGC to go towards their planned 100 seater stand within Tyn y Bryn Park.
- 8. Independent Remuneration Panel For Wales:** to consider whether to introduce an attendance allowance in line with the remuneration panel report for approved Council duties.
- 9. Public Footpaths:** to note that the upkeep and maintenance of public rights of way are not the responsibility of the Community Council, however, operatives will continue to react to any problem areas and assist where possible.
- 10. Summer Event:** to consider the Clerk's proposal to hold a number of smaller events this summer. The Clerk will present this report at the meeting.
- 11. Council Priorities for the next 5 years:** to consider areas which Councillors would like to be pursued as priorities for this term of the Council.
